

Variable Pricing Overview

In declining markets a fixed rate can lead to a higher overall cost than a market-based rate. The Independence Plan offers market-based pricing offerings from electricity suppliers, based on the regional wholesale index.

Since electricity is priced hourly throughout the day and is largely dependent upon overall demand, the Independence Plan offers potential savings to clients who consume energy during off-peak hours and those who can adjust their energy consumption to better take advantage of lower priced periods. Traditionally, the cost of electricity is less expensive during “off-peak” hours than during “peak” hours. For example, a manufacturing plant that opts to use more electricity overnight (off-peak hours) may see lower overall energy costs than similar manufacturers operating during peak hours.

Patriot Energy Group also offers a flexible, “light” plan in addition to our standard Independence Plan contract, which allows an initial 90-day trial period. At the end of the 90 days you may extend your contract, opt-out entirely, or choose a fixed rate strategy.
